Like a hammer (Jer. 23:29)

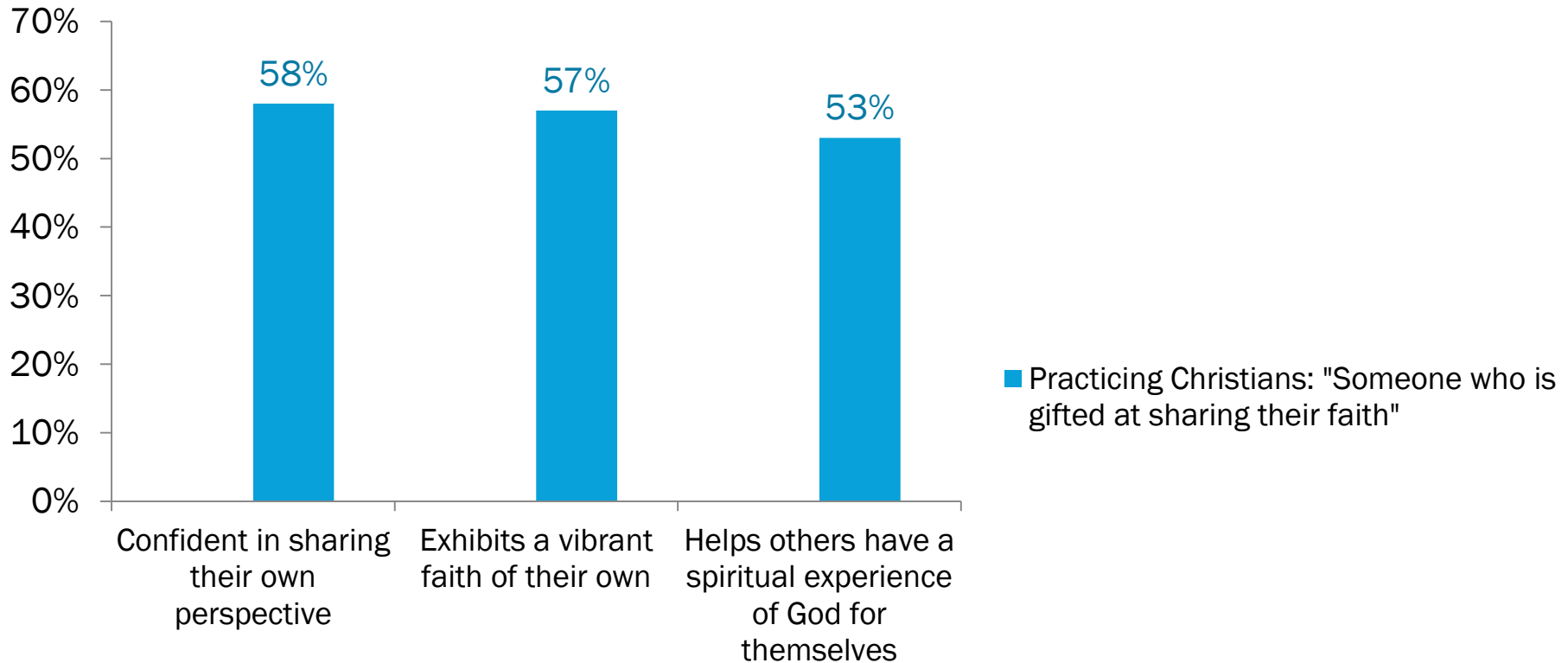
Like a sword (Heb. 4:12)

It shall stand forever (Isa. 40:7-9)

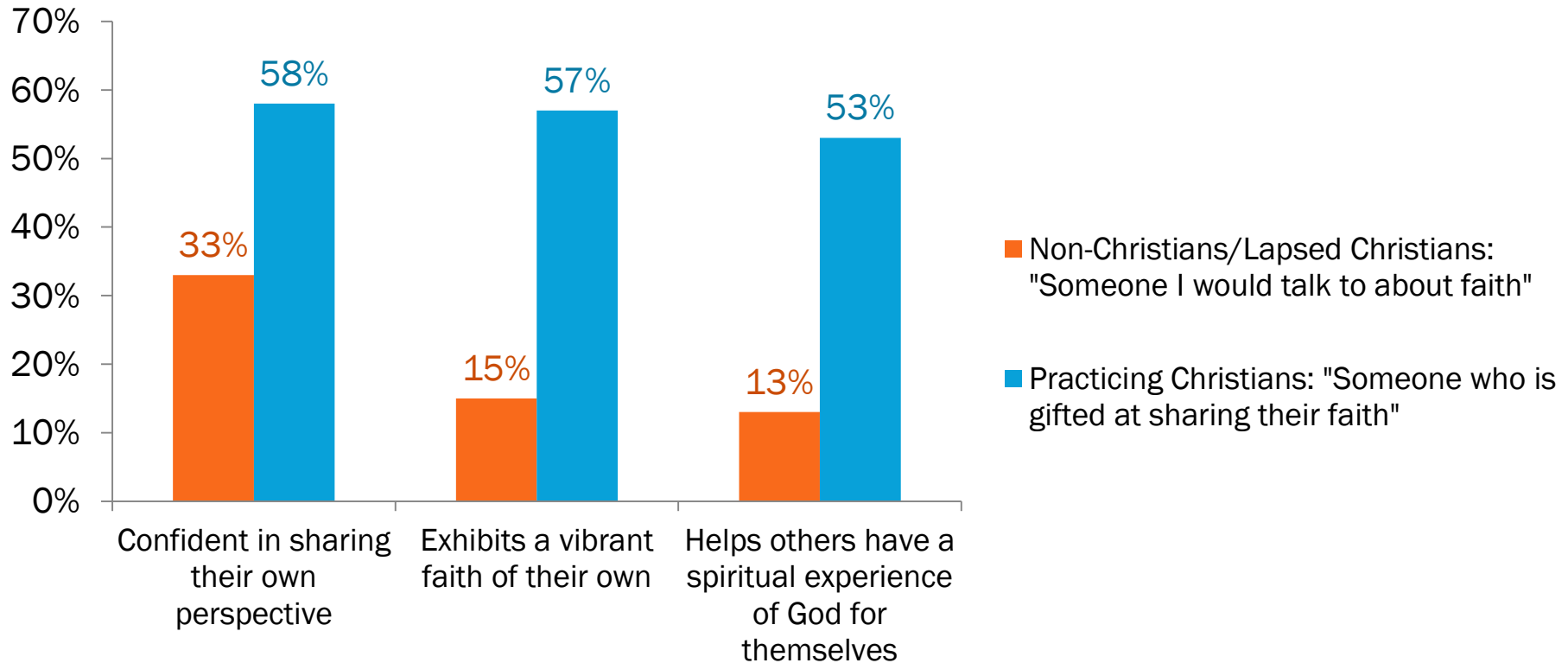
It shall accomplish its purpose (Isa. 55:10-11)



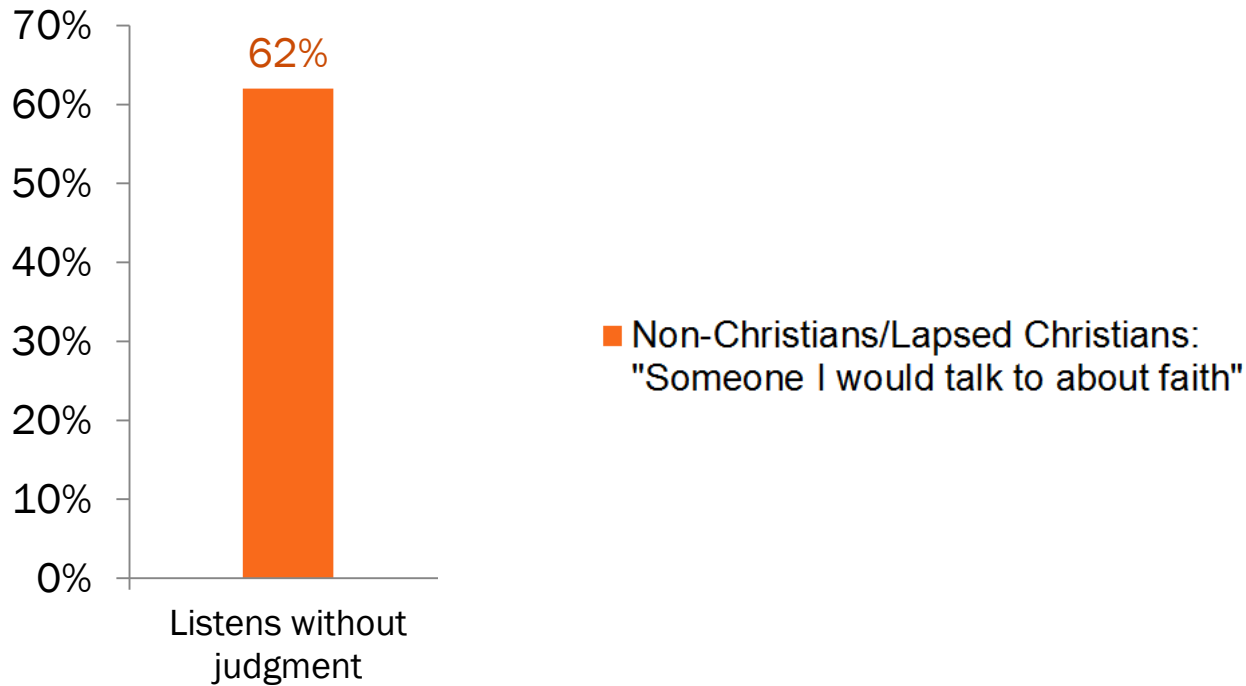
