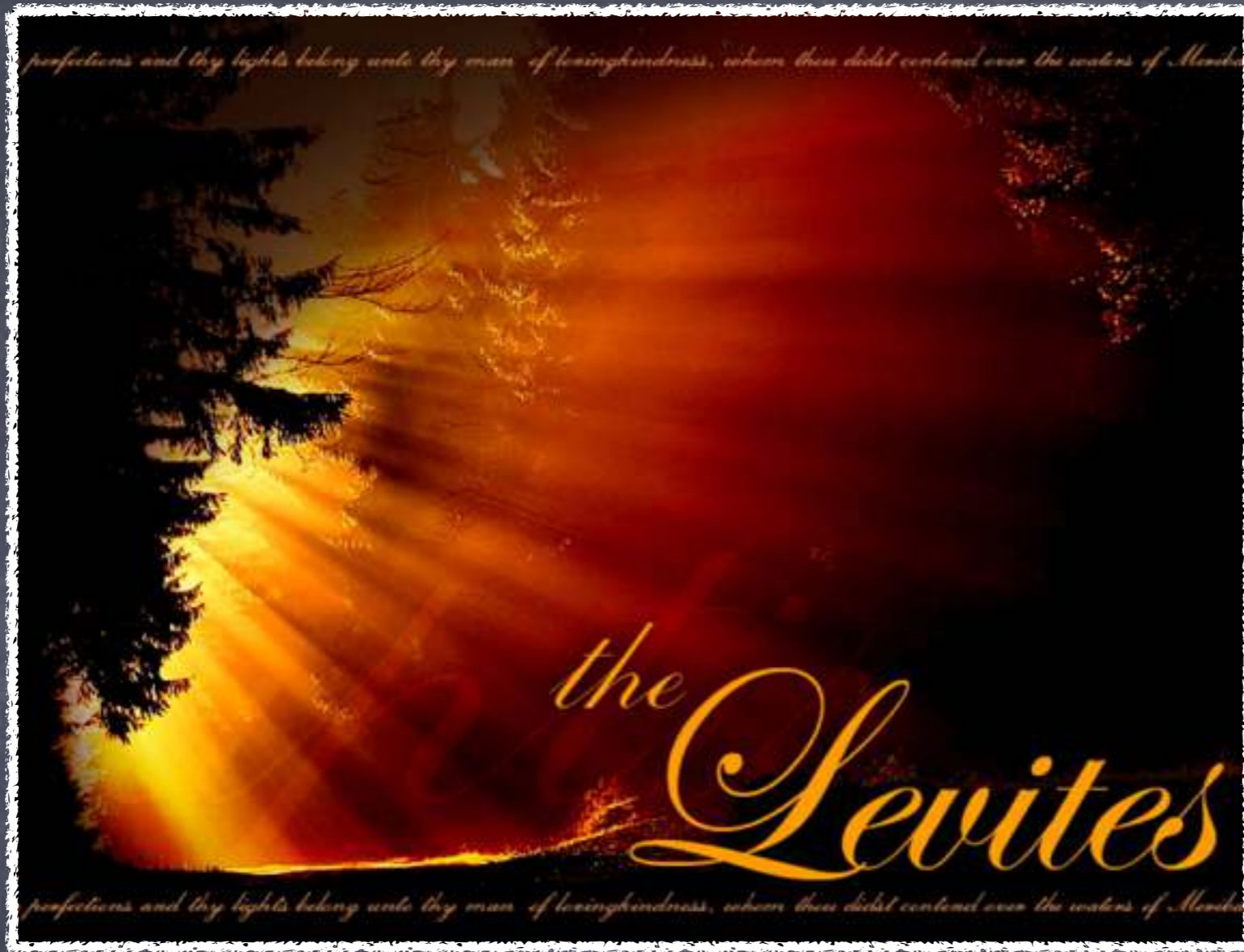

'Actionless' Lessons

- "I am going to do better at work"

'Actionable' Lessons

- "After seeing how hard the Levites worked in the wilderness, I am going to stop complaining about my job and start being really positive about work - working as to The Lord"
- "I have learned from the example of Asaph that we are all weak and anxious about how God works in our lives, about our own failings - I will be more open about these things in my marriage. I will let my guard down and be more honest"
- "I understand how the Sons of Korah separated themselves from their wicked family and I will separate myself from my sinful anger that I sometimes show towards my wife and my children"
