Acts 28:3 – 4

“escaped the sea,
yet Vengeance
suffereth not to live”



JONAH'S MIND

– Possible Explanations –

- What was going through the mind of Jonah at this time:
 - a) The penalty for his personal rebellion
 - a) A self-sacrifice for the lives of the mariners
 - a) The ultimate escape from God's mission

JONAH AND CHRIST

- Imperfect type of Christ -
- Mission was to call men to repentance
- Words were accompanied by great signs
- Was a willing sacrifice
- Taken and lifted up high
- Through death saved himself and others
